This is the petition filed by the petitioner seeking maintenance from the respondent section 125 Cr.P.C.

This matter was referred to Lok Adalat at the request of both parties by the 2nd Additional Judicial First Class Magistrate Court, Bhimavaram.

This petition is coming on for final settlement in the presence of the petitioner and Respondent and Sri A.Venkateswara Raju, Advocate for the petitioners and Sri B.Trimurthuluu, Advocate for the Respondent. Both parties to the petition have agreed for amicable settlement and filed terms of settlement with free will and volition. Hence, the following award is passed as per the settlement arrived by the parties.

AWARD

Both parties i.e., Petitioner/Petitioners and Respondent called present before the Lok Adalat and they have amicably compromised the matter before Lok Adalat without any influence from anybody and with their will and consent with following terms and conditions.

1. The respondent paid an amount of Rs. 20,00,000/- (in words Twenty Lakhs Rupees) to the 1st Petitioner Smt. Datla Bhavani on 29.04.2019 through RTGS transfer from the respondent Savings Bank Account ICICI Bank Bhimavaram Branch to the her savings Bank account STATE BANK OF INDIA, Chinna amiram Branch, bearing Account No. 62168483767 towards her permanent alimony i.e., for her life maintenance.
2. At request of the respondent his mother by name Smt. Datla Rama Sita had settled an extent of 329.6 Sq.Yards of site in R.S.NO. 177/2, situated at Pennada Village, Pennada Grama Panchayat area, Palakoderu Mandal, West Godavari District in favor of the 2nd Petitioner Datla Tarun Anjaneya Varma and she executed a Registered Settlement Deed dated 29.05.2019 under Document No. 3278 /2019 at S.R.O. Bhimavaram.
3. At request of the respondent his mother by name Smt. Datla Rama Sita also had settled an extent of 482 Sq.Yards of site in R.S.NO. 225/1, situated at Rayalam Village, Rayalam Grama Panchayat area, Bhimavaram Mandal, West Godavari District in favor of the 2nd Petitioner Datla Tarun Anjaneya Varma and she executed a Registered Settlement Deed dated 29.05.2019 under Document No.3278 /2019 at S.R.O. Bhimavaram.

4. The above Mentioned Two settlement Deeds are executed in favour of the 2nd petitioner towards permanent alimony.

5. The respondent also paid an amount of Rs. 35,48,000/- (in words Thirty Five Lakhs forty eight thousand Rupees) to the 2nd Petitioner Datla Tarun Anjaneya Varma by way of DEMAND DRAFT dated 31.05.2019 bearing D.D NO 500916 drawn on ICICI Bank, Bhimavaram Branch towards permanent alimony.

6. The 1st petitioner agreed to withdraw the Criminal Appeal No. 370/2018 which is filed by the 1st petitioner against the respondent and his mother on the file of Hon'ble III Additional District and Sessions Judge's Court, Bhimavaram.

7. The 1st petitioner agreed to co-operate to settle the Criminal Appeal No. 320/2018 which is filed by the respondent and his mother by name of Datla Rama Sita on the file of Hon'ble III Additional District and Sessions Judge's Court, Bhimavaram. The 1st petitioner also agreed to report the compromise terms to the Hon'ble III Additional District and Sessions Judge's Court, Bhimavaram in the above Criminal Appeal No. 320/2018 or before any court.

8. The respondent delivered Gold ornaments (Six Murugulu, One Molatadu and Ten Rings) of the 2nd petitioner to the 1st petitioner, which were in the custody of the respondent.

9. The respondent voluntarily delivered Gold ornaments (one Ring and one Chain) to the 1st petitioner, which were presented by the 1st petitioner's parents at the time of marriage to the respondent.

10. The 1st petitioner agreed to sign relevant Papers and Documents which are necessary in U.S.A to the respondent.

11. The 1st petitioner agreed to cooperate to give the Divorce to the Respondent.

12. The petitioners and respondent are agreed for not to file any cases or suits or any petitions against the each other in future and for not to interfere with their personal life.

We request the Lok Adalat to pass an award in terms of the settlement.

Both parties have affixed their signatures in the evidence of their consent for the terms of award.
