The convict is heard on the point of sentence. He submitted that the same is the first offence of the accused/ petitioner and he is the only bread earner of his poor family and therefore he may be exonerated from the charge or minimum fine may be kindly be emphasized.

Therefore, fine of Rupees 300/- (Three hundred only) is imposed on the said convict for their offence u/s. 144 of Railway Act. 1989. in default he shall undergo simple imprisonment for 15 days.

Accordingly the case is disposed of on plea of guilty of the accused person
