Upon perusal of the case record and considering the relevant documents of the case, there appears grounds for presuming that the accused person has committed offence punishable under section 36(1) of the Legal Metrology Act 2009, which this Court is competent to try and punish. The particulars of offence under the aforesaid section of law were read over and explained to the accused person to which he pleaded guilty.

The plea of guilt of the accused person is recorded in a separate sheet. As the accused person has pleaded guilty of the offence under section 36(1) of the Legal Metrology Act, 2009, I convict the accused person under the said section of steplant on thewally

Considering the nature of the offence committed, I have decided not to release the convicted person on probation under the provisions of the Probation of Offenders Act.

Accordingly, the accused person is convicted under section 36(1) of the Legal Metrology Act, 2009, and the convict is sentenced to pay a fine of Rs. 4000,00 (Rupees Four Thousand only) for the offence under 36(1) of the Legal Metrology Act, 2009 and in default to suffer simple imprisonment for a period & (one) month.

The accused person is allowed to go on executing a PR bond of Rs. 2000.00 (Rupees Two Thousand only) that he will appear as and when directed by the Court. PR bond 858/19 has been furnished by accused person Sri Dulu Rahman and same is accepted.
