Title Suit (Mutual Divorce) No. 01/2017

14.08.2017 This is a petition preferred by the petitioners Smti. Sumitra Nath and Sri Bulan Debnath under Sec. 13(B) of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 praying for dissolution of marriage between the petitioners on mutual consent.

It is stated in the petition that the marriage between the parties was solemnized on 03.03.2014 in accordance with Hindu Rites and Rituals and in due course, they were blessed with a male child namely Sri Jieet Nath. But during their conjugal life difference in taste, temperament and habit developed and as such, the relationship between the parties came to such an extent that it was not possible on their part to lead conjugal life and ultimately they have been residing separately since 01.03.2015. Under the aforesaid circumstances, both the petitioners mutually agreed and decided, as there is no scope for the continuance of their relationship as husband and wife, to dissolve their marriage on mutual consent.

I have heard both the petitioners in person as well as their Ld. Advocates. Efforts have been made to settle up the difference between the parties. Both the petitioners have stated that at present there is no chance of reunion between them and they want to live separately by way of mutual divorce.

The instant petition seeking mutual divorce was filed by the petitioners jointly on 06.01.2017 and both of them have appeared before this Court on 14.08.2017 i.e. after 6 (six) months of filing the aforesaid petition. As such, there is no legal bar to dissolve the marriage between the parties on mutual consent.

Under the aforesaid facts and circumstances in the light of the submission of the petitioners as well as their Ld.

Advocates, it appears that both the parties are not at all interested to lead conjugal life and there is also no scope of their reunion and as such, the marriage between the parties stands dissolved on mutual consent, as prayed for.

Prepare the decree accordingly.
