APPLICATION FOR CORRECTION OF MISTAKE/ERROR IN THE
CHART OF ALLOTMENT UNDER SECTION 446 OF THE GOA
SUCCESSION SPECIAL NOTARIES AND INVENTORY
PROCEEDING ACT, 2012.

MAY IT PLEASE YOUR HONOUR

That the Applicant above named states and submits as under:-

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1. That present inventory proceeding was initiated upon the death of late Shri. Shaikh Hamid alias Sheikh Hamid and his wife late Habibjahan Shaikh alias Habibjaan Shaikh alias Habibjahan Sheikh before this Hon'ble Court.
2. That this Hon'ble Court was pleased to pass the final order in these proceedings on 20th January 2016.
3. That the present inventory was settled by the interested parties by filing Chart of allotment which is marked at Exhbt. A-27 with consent and all the parties have even annexed the sketch showing different area of all the interested parties.
4. That when the interested parties approached the Mamlatdar of Sanguem for mutation at that time it was realized that in the Chart of Allotment at Exhbit A-27 at page No. 71 and at page No. 73 while doing allotment of Plot F and Plot G there crept some clerical or arithmetical mistakes in mentioning survey number and its area so also the sketch produced along with the said allotment was also clubbed sketch of all the survey numbers and sub divided plots and due to which identification of the respective plots allotted to the respective parties was little difficult and confusing.
5. That the cabas de casal and all the interested parties accordingly decided for rectification of error remained in plot F and plot G while allotment and to substitute new independent sketches showing the respective plots allotted to all the 10 respective interested parties and their legal heirs in order to avoid confusion and to bring transparency.
6. That in view of above the cabas de casal in the present inventory proceeding, files the present application to rectify the mistake remained while making allotment of survey numbers and its area in plot F and plot G at page No. ~~72~~ and ~~73~~ and wanted to substituting new sketch showing independent

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plots of all the 10 sets of interested parties i.e. 10 different sketches showing independent plots of all the 10 sets of interested parties and Plot F and Plot G shall be rectified as follows:-

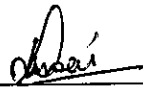
