State Vs. Gopi Singh

Challan presented today. It be checked and registered. Copy of challan has been supplied to the accused free of costs, as envisaged, under Section 207 of Cr.P.C.

Heard. From the perusal of challan u/s 173 Cr.P.C. and other accompanied documents, a prima facie case for commission of offence punishable under Section 13-A of the Public Gambling Act, 1867 is made out against the accused. A separate notice of accusation served upon him, to which he pleaded guilty and did not claim trial.

Vide separate judgment of even date, the accused has been held guilty for the commission of offence punishable under Section 13-A of the Public Gambling Act, 1867, and sentenced to pay a fine of **Rs.200/-** for the commission of offence punishable under Section 13-A of the Public Gambling Act, 1867, and in default of payment of fine, he shall undergo simple imprisonment for a period of two days. **Fine paid.** Case property be confiscated to the State. File after due compliance be consigned to the record-room.
