State versus Jitender Singh @ Cheeta

Accused Jitender Singh @ Cheeta is in custody and

represented by Advocate C.P. Kalra.

File taken up today as the accused surrendered before the Court. He was taken into custody. Advocate C.P. Kalra filed power of attorney on behalf of the accused. He moved an application for seeking regular bail of the accused. Copy given. Reply not filed. Argument heard. After hearing the rival contentions of learned counsel for both sides and going through the case file very carefully and minutely, this Court is of considered view that the accused is entitled to concession of regular bail because firstly nothing has to be recovered from him, secondly the trial will take a considerable time and no useful purpose will be served by detaining him behind the bar and thirdly the offence in present case is triable by Court of Judicial Magistrate Ist Class. Therefore, without commenting anything on the merits of present case, instant bail application is hereby allowed and consequently the accused is admitted on regular bail subject to furnishing of bail in the sum of Rs.40,000/- with one surety in like amount. Bail bond and surety bond are furnished which are accepted and attested. Notice under Section 446 of Cr.P.C. was served upon the accused to which he pleaded guilty and did not claim trial. Fine of Rs. 3,000/- was imposed. Fine paid. The accused be released from custody in present case. Now, case is adjourned to 22.10.2019, the date already fixed.
