having fruity. When the complainant regained his consciousness at 06:00

pm, he found his E-rickshaw missing along with mobile No.99960-60334

and Rs.2,000/-. The complainant further alleged that in the state of

consciousness, he reached his house. The complainant requested for legal

action. On these allegations, FIR was registered under sections 379-A,

328 read with section 34 IPC on 02.10.2017.

3. Investigation was carried out. Statements of the witnesses were

recorded. Rough site plan was prepared. Accused were arrested.

**4.** Copies of challan thereof were supplied to the accused free of cost in

compliance of section 208 Cr.P.C. on 15.01.2018.
