Hence following:

ORDER

Acting under Section 252 of Cr.P.C.,
accused is convicted for offence punishable
under Section 279 of IPC and he is sentenced
to pay a fine of Rs.1,000/- for the said
offence. In default, he shall undergo S.I. for a
period of 15 days.

Acting under Section 252 of Cr.P.C.,
accused is convicted for offence punishable
under Section 337 of IPC and he is sentenced
to pay a fine of Rs.500/- for the said
offence. In default, he shall undergo S.I. for a
period of 15 days.

Acting under Section 252 of Cr.P.C.,
accused is convicted for offence punishable
under Section 338 of IPV and he is sentenced
to pay a fine of Rs.1,000/- for the said

offence. In default, he shall undergo S.I. for a period of 15 days.

Accused is sentenced to pay fine of Rs.2,500/-.Accused submits that he would remit the entire fine amount.

Office is directed to receive the fine.
