



ORDER BELOW EXH.1 IN R.C.C. NO. 1/2018
(Subhash Gahinaji Barse Vs. Asha Prabhakar Borade
and others)

This is a private complaint case filed under section 323, 395, 504, 506 r.w. 34 of Indian Penal Code. The present matter is captioned for taking steps on behalf of the complainant. In spite of giving more than sufficient opportunity, the complainant failed to take effective steps. Therefore, on 20-12-2018 specific directions were given to take effective steps. But he failed to do so. Therefore, on 31-01-2019 the matter was kept for DID order. Thereafter, on 05-04-2019 the complainant filed an application vide Exh.5 and sought time for taking steps. But thereafter also he did not take proper steps. Therefore, on 17-08-2019 again the proceeding was kept for DID order. Today also neither complainant nor his Ld. Advocate appeared before the court. Moreover, the complainant failed to take effective steps. It shows that, the complainant is not interested to proceed with the matter. In my view there is no reason to keep pending matter before the court. Hence, I pass the following order:

ORDER

1. The complaint is dismissed for want of prosecution.
2. The accused are discharged for the offences punishable under section 323, 395, 504, 506 r.w. 34 of Indian Penal Code.
