ORDER PASSED BELOW EXHIBIT 1
(Date 05.03.2018)

This is an application under section 2 of Bombay Regulation VIII of 1827 for grant them a certificate of heirship. It is submitted by applicant that applicant no.1 is widow wife, applicant nos 2 to 4 are son and applicant nos.5, 6 are daughters of deceased Laxminarayan Gangaiya Panchgam, who died on 17-05-2015 at Nagpur. As per the applicants they are only legal heirs of deceased.

2] I issued the citation notice and paper publication for calling the objection if any. Accordingly, the report of bailiff received to this court at Exh.7, stating that the notice was affixed in the office of Collector, Amravati, Municipal Corporation, Amravati respectively. The proclamation was issued in daily news paper "Loksarkar" dated 26.01.2018, inviting persons who disputes the right of applicant to appear within one month from the date of proclamation and file their objections. However, no person appeared and filed any objection

disputing the right of applicant.

3] In order to prove the application, the applicant no.4 has filed his affidavit at Exh.10. The evidence of applicant no.4 is remained unchallenged. They have also relied upon the Death Certificate of deceased Laxminarayan Gangaiya Panchgam, verified copies of Election card of applicant Nos. 1,2,5,6 and Aadhaar card of applicant no.3 which is at Exh. 11 to 17 respectively. Moreover, applicant relied on copy of Paper publication of notice and its receipt in “Loksarkar” at Exh.18 &19.

4] Considering the matter it appears that applicants are the only legal heirs of deceased Laxminarayan Gangaiya Panchgam. Therefore, application deserves to be allowed. Hence the order :

ORDER

1. Application is allowed.
2. Issue certificate of heirship (in Appendix B) *vide* section 2 of Bombay Regulations VIII of 1827 in favor of the applicants as a legal heirs of deceased Laxminarayan Gangaiya Panchgam.
3. The applicants shall pay the court fees as per rules.
4. The note be appended to the heirship certificate as per para 312 of Civil Manual.
