

BEFORE NATIONAL LOK-ADALAT, HELD AT - CHANDRAPUR

ORDER

(Dated 22.04.2018)

Petitioner/Original respondent has preferred this revision being aggrieved by the judgment and order passed by Labour Court, Chandrapur in Complaint (ULP) 10/2015. Respondent/Original complainant had filed complaint to challenge impugned dismissal order dated 15.05.2014. Labour Court held that said order is illegal and by issuing it respondent has engaged in unfair labour practice and thereby directed the respondent to reinstate the complainant with continuity of service and to pay the back wages for the period i. e. from dismissal till actual reinstatement. Respondent had challenged the said order before this Court. Both the parties have appeared in Lok-Adalat alongwith their respective advocates. They have filed compromise pursis below Exh.U-C-1. The petitioner is ready to reinstate the complainant with continuity of service on it original post within 20 days from the date of receipt of copy of this order. Original complainant is ready to relinquish his claim of back wages. Both parties have admitted the contents of pursis Exh.U-C-1. Hence, matter is disposed of in view of said pursis and I pass following order.

ORDER

Respondent is directed to reinstate the complainant within 20 days from the date of receipt of this order. Complainant is not entitled for back wages from the date of dismissal till actual reinstatement. In default to reinstate the

complainant within aforesaid period. Complainant
is entitled for back wages.
