

ORDER BELOW EXH.1 IN M.A.C.P.M.A.NO.01 of 2018

[Shubham Ashok Koli Vs. United India Insurance Co. Ltd. Jalgaon.]

By way of present application, the applicant has prayed for grant of withdrawal of amount which is granted in favour of the applicant vide order passed in M.A.C.P. No.344/2009 and kept in fixed deposit scheme and as he is in need of money and therefore, it is prayed for withdrawal of the said amount.

2] Heard learned advocate Mr. M.S. Chaudhari for the applicant. Perused application, supported by affidavit (Exh.5) and accompanied documents along-with list of documents Exh.4 at serial Nos.1 to 5 and the Office Report dtd. 09/01/2018 below Exh.1.

3] It appears from the Office Report dtd. 09/01/2018 and the documents, that a sum of Rs.10,000/- is kept in Vijay Bank, branch Jalgaon for the period of 02.11.2010 to 02.11.2017 vide F.D.R. No.207966 in the name of applicant Shubham Ashok Koli.

4] Considering the fact that the applicant has attained the age of majority and that said amount is required for the purpose of applicant's education, the amount kept in the F.D.R. is required to be released. Hence, I proceed to pass following order :-

ORDER

i] Present application is allowed.

ii] The amount of Rs.10,000/- kept in Vijaya Bank, branch Jalgaon vide F.D.R.No.207966, be paid to applicant Shubham Ashok Koli through account payee cheque in his name, along-with accrued interest, as per rule, on his proper identification and verification.

iii] Inform the concerned Bank accordingly.
