**Application for issuing the legal heir-ship certificate under the
Bombay Regulation Act.**

JUDGMENT

(Delivered on 7th March, 2018)

This application is for issuing the legal heir-ship certificate under the Bombay Regulation Act.

Brief facts of applicants case in short are as under:-

2. Applicant no.1 is widow and applicant no.2 and 3 are

children of deceased Gangadharrao Bhumannaji Sutrave. On 02-10-2017 deceased Gangadharrao Bhumannaji Sutrave left for heaven abode at his residential house at near Ram temple, Pansarenagar, Tq. Dharmabad. Applicants are the legal heirs of deceased Gangadharrao Bhumannaji Sutrave and they required the legal heir-ship certificate in their favour for electricity meter, gas connection, ration card so also government office work. Therefore, applicants have filed the present application.

3. Accordingly, the paper publication was issued but none have appeared and raised the objection.

4. On the basis of pleading, documents placed on record the following points arise for my determination and I have recorded my findings with reason thereon as under :-

REASONS FOR THE FINDINGS

5. In order to prove their contentions applicant no.1 Chandrakala Gangadharrao Sutrave (PW1) entered into witness box and reiterated the entire contents of her application in affidavit (Exh.11). According to her, deceased Gangadharrao Bhumannaji Sutrave died on 02-10-2017 near Ram temple, Pansarenagar, Tq. Dharmabad. In support of his contention he filed the copy of death certificate of deceased Gangadharrao Bhumannaji Sutrave (Exh.12).

6. Chandrakala (PW1) further contended that apart from applicants none are legal heirs of deceased Gangadharrao Bhumannaji Sutrave. Similarly, she relied on the documentary evidence like legal

heir-ship Certificate (Exh.13) issued by Police Patil Ratnali/Balapur, Aadhar Card of applicant no.1 to 3 (Exh.14 to 16) respectively. Accordingly, the publication (Exh.17) in the daily news paper “Godateer Samachar” was published that applicants are the legal heirs deceased Gangadharrao Bhumannaji Sutrave. None have appear and raised the objection.

7. Applicants have also contended that they required the legal heir-ship certificate for electricity meter, gas connection, ration card so also government office work. In view of above facts, circumstances and the documents placed on record I am of the view that applicants are only legal heirs of deceased Gangadharrao Bhumannaji Sutrave. Hence, I proceed to pass the following order.

ORDER

1. Application is allowed.
2. Issue legal heir-ship certificate in favour of applicant no.1.Chandrakala Gangadharrao Sutrave, applicant no.2. Hemant Gangadharrao Sutrave, applicant no.3. Sharad Gangadharrao Sutrave for electricity meter, gas connection, ration card so also government office work as per Bombay Regulation Act on the payment of requisite court fees.
