

ORDER BELOW EXH.01 IN R.J.E. No.01/2018.
Manjulabai V/S. S.B.I., Sonkhed & Ors.

01) Heard Shri. S. J. Wagdare, learned Advocate for the petitioners.

02) Perused the petition and pursis Exh.25 filed by the petitioners.

03) The present petition has been filed by the petitioners under section 372 of the Indian Succession Act, for grant of succession certificate. It is case of applicants that the deceased Govindrao Ramrao More during his lifetime has deposited an amount of Rs.4,31,200/- in his pension Account No.62002892418 with respondent No.01 i.e. State bank of India, branch Sonkhed and deposited an amount of Rs.1,14,212/- in Account No.100711002003251 & Account No.100711111102767 with respondent No.02 i.e. Nanded Central Co-operative Bank Ltd, Nanded, branch Sidko Nanded. Thereby, petitioners claim the succession certificate for an amount of Rs.4,31,200/- and Rs.1,14,212/- total amount of Rs.5,45,412/-. The said claim amount for succession certificate is more than Rs.5,00,000/-. The pecuniary jurisdiction of this court of Civil Judge Junior Division, at Loha, does not exceed Rs.5,00,000/-. The applicants have filed the pursis at Exh.25 and contended that the claim of applicants in the petition is more than the pecuniary jurisdiction of this Court.

04) The petition should have been presented to the Court of Civil Judge Senior Division, Kandhar whose pecuniary jurisdiction is unlimited. Under such set of circumstance, it is just and proper to returned the petition to the petitioners for being presented to the proper Court. Hence, I am inclined to pass following order.

ORDER

- 1) The present petition be returned to the petitioners for being presented to the proper Court.
