

Sessions Case No.1/2018.

O R D E R (Below Exh.5)

1. The applicant/ accused Sandesh Sanjay Kamble filed this application for cancellation of one of condition of bail of attendance at police station. According to him, the investigation is completed and there is no necessity of further interrogation by police.

2. The prosecution submitted say at Exh. 7 through the learned APP for the State and thereby submitted that the prosecution has no objection to cancel condition of attendance at police station.

3. Heard the learned counsel for the applicant/ accused and the learned APP for the State.

4. It is not disputed that the applicant/ accused was arrested in Crime No. 104/2014 registered at Sanjay Nagar Police Station, for the offence under Sections 302 r.w. 34 of the IPC. While releasing the applicant/ accused on bail by order dated 12.10.2017 in Criminal Bail Application No. 775/2017, one of the condition imposed on him was that he shall attend at Sanjay Nagar Police Station on every Monday between 01.00 p.m. to 04.00 p.m till further orders. It is not disputed that now investigation is completed and charge sheet is filed in this Court and it is

pending for framing of charge. Therefore, it appears that now attendance of the applicant/ accused at police station for further investigation is not necessary. In that circumstances, I find that the applicant is found entitled for cancellation of condition of attendance at police station. Hence the order.

ORDER

1. The application Exh. 5 is hereby allowed.
2. The condition of attendance on Sunday at police station imposed against the applicant/ accused while releasing him on bail as per order dated 12.10.2017 in Criminal Bail Application No 775/2017 is hereby cancelled.
3. Inform to the concerned police station accordingly.
