

Order Below Exh. 1 in S.T.C.No. 1 /18

Read the complaint and affidavit in lieu of verification of the complainant. Perused the documents filed below Exh. 3. After considering the documents on record it seems that accused issued cheque bearing no. 000964 dated 25/10/2017 to the complainant for discharge of liabilities, but that cheque is returned for reason "insufficient funds", the complainant issued demand notice to accused, but he failed to comply it. Thus, it seems that the complainant has made out all the compliance as per section 138 of Negotiable Instrument Act against accused. The complainant deposited the disputed cheque in " Central Bank of India, branch Vairag." The said bank is situated within the territorial jurisdiction of this court. Hence there are sufficient grounds to proceed against accused. Hence, I pass the following order.

ORDER

Issue process against accused for an offence punishable under section 138 of Negotiable Instrument Act.
