has filed the suit and has claimed the relief that the defendant being her

husband is going to sell the suit property i.e. ancestral property of the

defendant specifically when the defendant is also deserted the plaintiff

and his children from her matrimonial house and non maintaining the

plaintiff, so in the interest of justice and prima facie case, maintenance is

the first charge. So, under these circumstances, at this stage and in the interest

of justice, I found it fit that ex-parte interim relief may be granted to the

plaintiffs. Defendant is ordered to be summoned for 22.02.2018 in the

meantime, the defendant is restrained not to sell the property till the next date of

hearing. The compliance under Order 39 Rule 3 CPC be made within two

working days, failing which the ex-parte ad-interim order shall stands vacated

automatically.
