No reply to the bail application has been filed, however, learned APP for the State contested the bail application on the ground that the accused was declared proclaimed offender and as such, he is not entitled to concession of bail.

Heard. Perusal of original file reveals that accused Gurpreet Singh was declared proclaimed offender vide order dated 24.04.2010, passed by the then learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Samana. As such, the accused Gurpreet Singh has already misused the concession of bail. Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, this Court is of the considered opinion that accused-applicant Gurpreet Singh is not entitled to concession of bail. Hence, the bail application filed on behalf of accused-applicant Gurpreet Singh is hereby dismissed. Papers be tagged with the main file.
