The present appeal has been filed under Section 341 Cr.P.C. praying that the respondent be prosecuted for having produced documents by not following the procedure prescribed under the Indian Evidence Act.

On asking of the court, the learned counsel for the appellant has read Section 14 of the Family Court Act. The learned counsel for the appellant has also very fairly admitted that no document was forged or fabricated while in the custody of the court. That being so, seeing the imminent fate of the case, the learned counsel for the appellant has prayed that the present appeal be dismissed as not pressed with liberty to the appellant to raise all arguments at appropriate stage before appropriate court so that any observation made by this Court may not prejudice the appellant.

As prayed, the present appeal is dismissed as not

pressed with liberty aforesaid, in view of Section 14 of the Family Court and the judgments rendered by the courts regarding holding of inquiry under Section 340 Cr.P.C to lift the bar prescribed under Section 195 Cr.P.C.
