- [1] Petitioner Himendu Sinha is present. His wife Sagarika Dhar is also present in person. She has filed written statement in court. It is submitted by the respondent that she lives with her kid at Delhi where she is doing a job in a firm. She is therefore urges the court for expeditious disposal of the case.
- [2] I have made an effort for amicable settlement between them and accordingly I have tried for a settlement but such efforts did not work. I have recorded the evidence of the petitioner. I have also recorded the evidence of his respondent wife and heard arguments of their advocates.
- [3] It is known from the petitioner that it is quite impossible on her part to leave her job because her husband does not have sufficient income to support their son for his bringing. It is pleaded by her that she has offered her husband to come to Delhi and stay with her. But he is not willing to go there.
- [4] The husband on the other hand, submits that he cannot leave his old and ailing parents alone at home and go to Delhi for staying with his wife. Therefore he filed this case for restitution of conjugal rights.
- [5] After hearing both sides I have rejected the petition for restitution of conjugal rights by a judgment delivered in separate sheets of paper. Retain the judgment in record. The case is disposed off on contest. Supply a copy of order free of cost to the parties.
