## :: O R D E R ::

Both petitioners present. Learned counsel for both petitioners present. Reconciliation talks held for the reunion of both petitioners, but in vain. On the other hand, both of them submitted that there is no possibility for their reunion and decided to take divorce. Both of them represented that they have not withdrawn the petition.
