ORDER

A.1 to A.8 are present, copies of case documents are furnished to them. They are examined under section 251 of Cr.P.C. by stating the accusation for the offence punishable under section 9(1) of A.P.Gaming Act. The accused pleaded guilty of the said offence. On the own admission of the accused, I find the accused guilty of the said offence under section 9(1) of A.P.Gaming Act. and accordingly , convict him for the offence under section 252 Cr.P.C. Heard, the accused on question of sentence, they stated that they are poor person and they are having wife, old aged parents and children and if they are sent to Jail, their entire family will suffer. Having regard to the submission made by the accused and nature of offence against them sending them to Jail would no purpose and if they sentenced to pay fine that would meet the ends of Justice. Accordingly, the A.1 to A.8 are convicted under section 252 Cr.P.C. and sentenced to pay a fine of Rs.300/- for offence under section 9(1) of A.P.Gaming Act and in default to suffer S. I. for one week each. The seized total amount of Rs.23,100/- shall be confiscated to the State forthwith and (52) playing cards is ordered to be destroyed forthwith. Total fine imposed is Rs.2400/-
