Applicant is a Partnership Firm. The applicant and respondent authorities have entered into a work contract on 11.09.2009, which has an arbitration clause. A dispute has arisen between the parties. Now the applicant approached this Court by filing the present application under Section 11(6) of the Arbitration & Conciliation Act 1996 for appointment of the arbitrator in the matter. Learned counsel for the respondent has no objection, if this Court appoints an arbitrator in the matter.

In view of above, Mr. S.K. Raturi – Retired District Judge of Uttarakhand, whose name has been commonly suggested by both the parties, is appointed as Arbitrator in the matter who presently resides in Dehradun.

All the disputes, therefore, which has arisen between the parties in relation to the contract dated 11.09.2009 are therefore, referred for arbitration before Mr. S.K. Raturi, District Judge (Retd.), Uttarakhand.

In view thereof, the Arbitration application stands disposed.
