Revisionists are absent on calls. None appears on behalf of the revisionists. No step is taken on their behalf. Contesting respondents are represented by their ld. counsel.

Today is fixed for filing show cause by the revisionists. No show cause is found submitted by or on their behalf. It is submitted by ld. counsel for the contesting respondents that the revisionists since filing of this case have lost their interest to proceed with the hearing of this case and accordingly it is prayed to dismiss the case.

Heard ld. counsel for the contesting respondents. Considered.

On perusal of the case record I find challenging the order no. 65 dt. 02.08.18 passed in TS No. 20/14 this revisional application has been instituted on 23.08.18 and next date was fixed on 11.10.18 for SR and appearance and on the date the contesting respondents made their appearance but from that date revisionists have not been taking any step to proceed with the case and Court was compelled to direct them to submit show cause why this case shall not be dismissed. It appears from their conduct that they are not interested to proceed with the case anymore. Considering the conduct of the revisionists on record and also the submission of ld. counsel for contesting respondents, I find no justified ground to adjourn the hearing of the case for unlimited period inspite of the absence of the revisionists.

Hence, it is

ordered

that Civil revision 01/18 is and the same be dismissed for default but without any cost.
