### **Disadvantaged Party:**

The students and their instructors could be disadvantaged due to the broad descriptions of the syllabus topics, making targeted preparation more challenging.

#### **Overall Risk Score:**

Low — The document serves its purpose but could benefit from additional clarity and guidance to improve the utility for students preparing for the exam.

- Enhance the syllabus section with detailed subtopic information.
